Who Can Attend:

- For non-native speakers, advanced English language is required: TOEFL 550 PBT, 80 iBT; IELTS 6.5; or the equivalent. If you do not have sufficient English skills to attend this program, you may join an English language program first.
- Bachelor's degree required.
- No GMAT or management experience required.
- This program requires an F-1 visa for international applicants.
- To continue in the Master's portion of the coursework, you must complete your Postgraduate Diploma with a minimum GPA of 70%.
